How To Have Your Say

The Inquiry is looking at how Queensland's child safety system can be improved. They want to hear from children, young people, families, carers, workers, and community members. You can get involved in different ways:

Write

- Send a **submission** (a letter, email, or document).
- Share your story, views, or ideas for change.
- Submissions can be public, private, or anonymous.
- The Commission will read all submissions. They may contact you for more information.
- If you make an anonymous submission, this will mean they cannot contact or respond to you.

Speak

- **Public Hearings** will be held in different regions across Queensland.
- Some people may be invited to speak as witnesses.
- Hearings are usually open to the public.

Meet

- Take part in **community consultations, focus groups, or meetings**.
- Talk directly with Inquiry staff about your experiences.
- Sessions will be advertised online and in local communities.

Share

- Give the Inquiry important information or evidence.
- This could be reports, letters, data, or case examples.
- You can share information **confidentially or anonymously** if you wish.

Contribute Expertise or Experience

- Professionals can provide research or expert advice.
- People with **lived experience** can explain what works — and what doesn't.
- Both are equally valuable.

- Attend hearings as an observer.
- Share information with others so more voices are heard.
